Year 2/3 class update - Successful Organizations

As we are in week 4 of our inquiry unit of How We Organise Ourselves. Students have taken keen interests in a variety of organisations and clubs that are beneficial to their success. Last week, students created their own organisation and invited all students and staff members to vote for the organisation they would like to join. Over the next week or two, students are looking into questions they have around our central idea of people create organisations to solve problems and support human endeavor and enterprise.



Student inquiries are:

Phee - How do they make building materials? Ophelia - How do they make hamburgers from a cow? Daewa - How to help poor dogs that don't have a home? Homeless dogs. Jennesa - How do you help very sick people? Dean - What are some good organizations for me (7-8 ages)? Zen - How do markets get their food? Mint - How can dogs run? How dogs can jump? Belty - How do people make sandwiches? Ryu - How to help people become smart? Eric - How to run faster than a car?

After students are given time to research using computers and books. Each will present their findings to the class.
