With some of the solutions we used heat and other mixtures we used filter paper. It took a long time but we were able to recover our original sands and salts.

In the Year 11 Science Class the students have been learning about the human body. As part of this unit the students have been exploring the different organs that make up the body. They can be seen dissecting an animal heart and exploring the human brain.
